7. Honour from the uniform of the USSR officers.



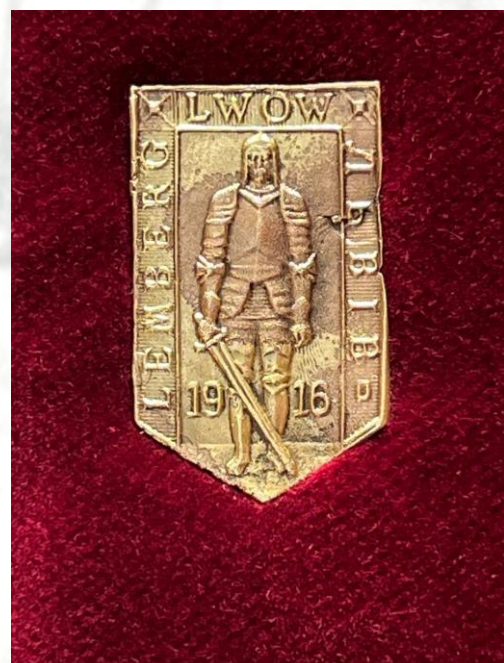
8. A military cockade from the period of the collapse of the Austro-Hungarian Empire (1917).
